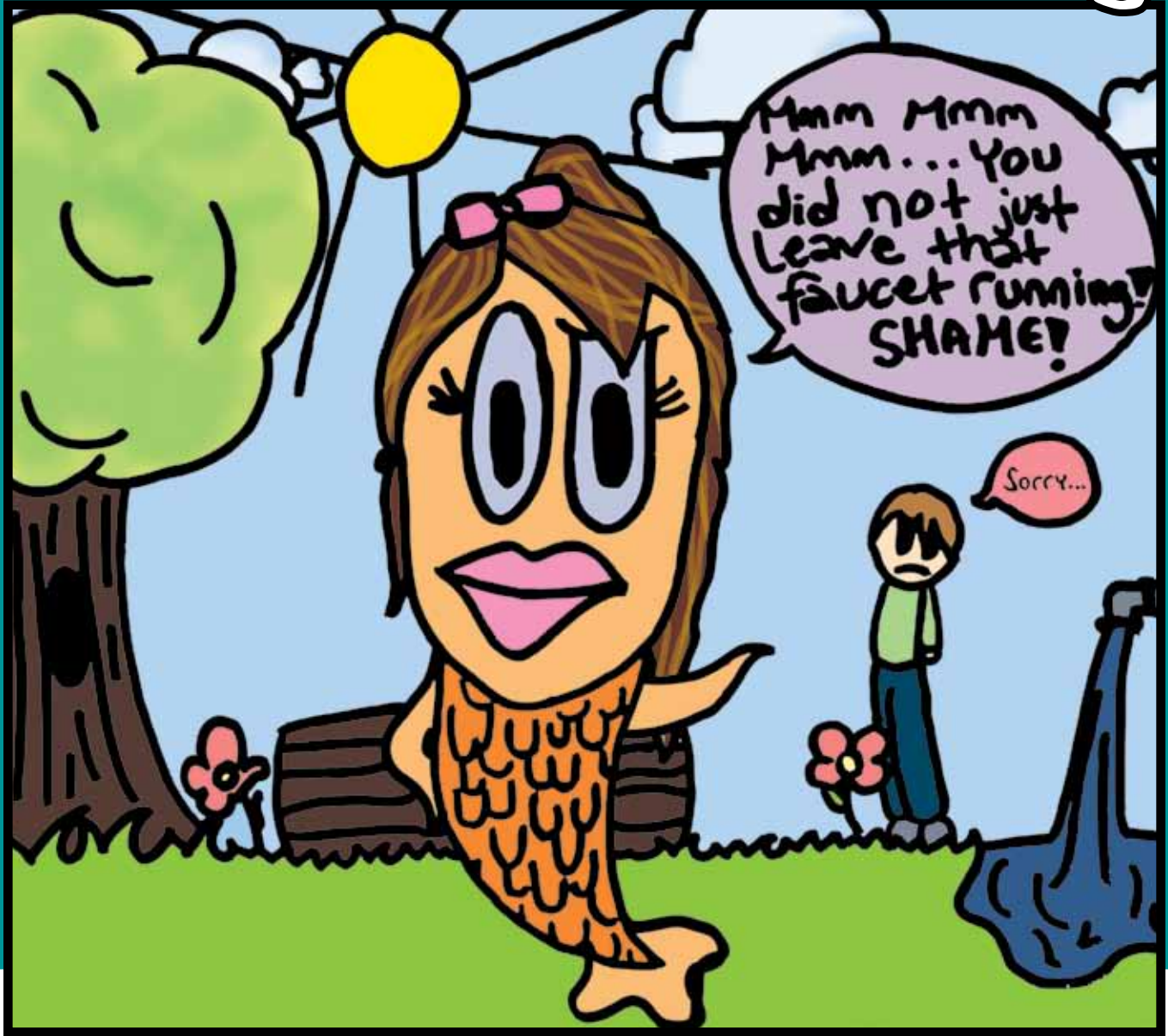

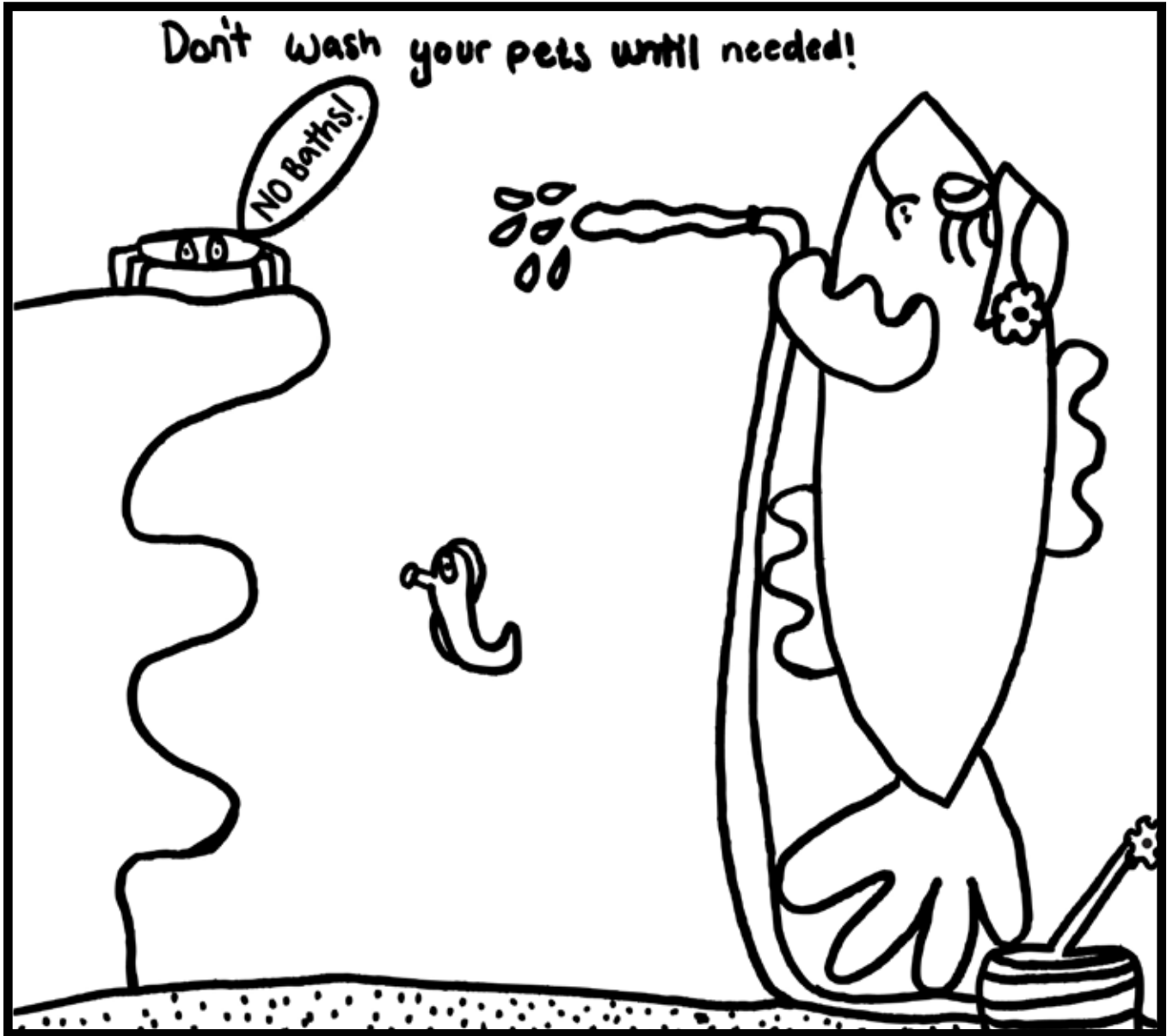

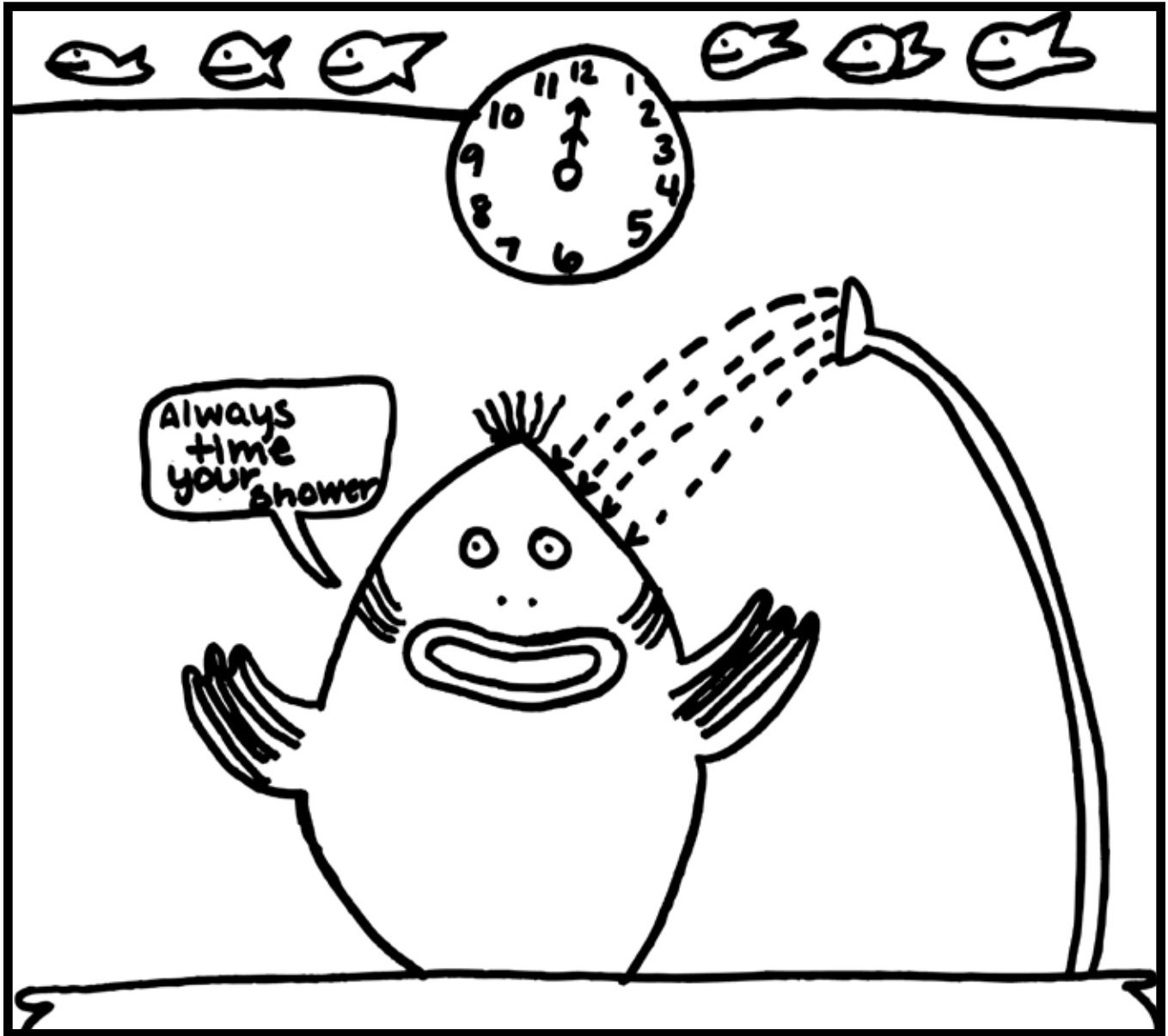
Only wash your pet when necessary, and be sure to turn off the hose after rinsing them.

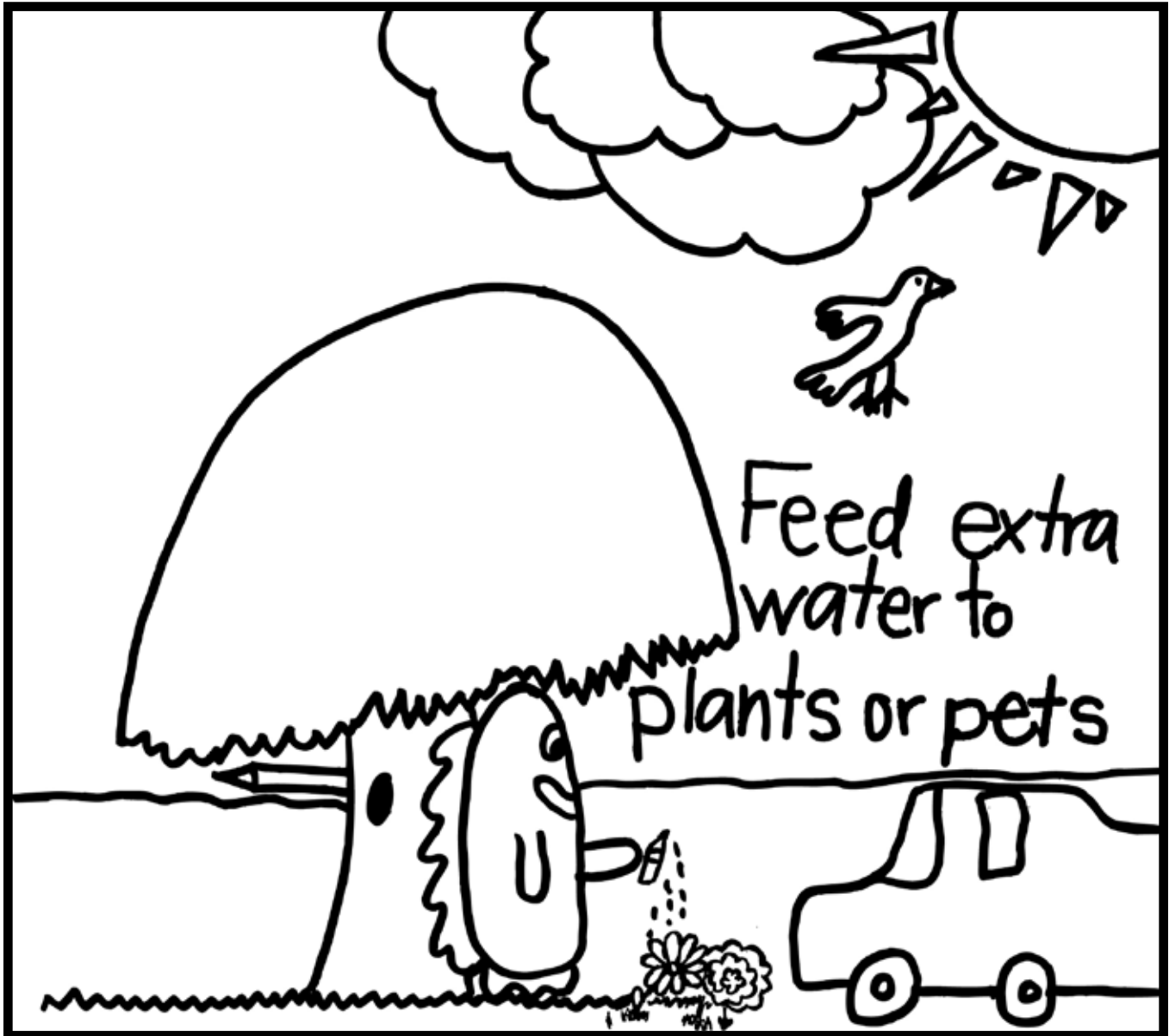

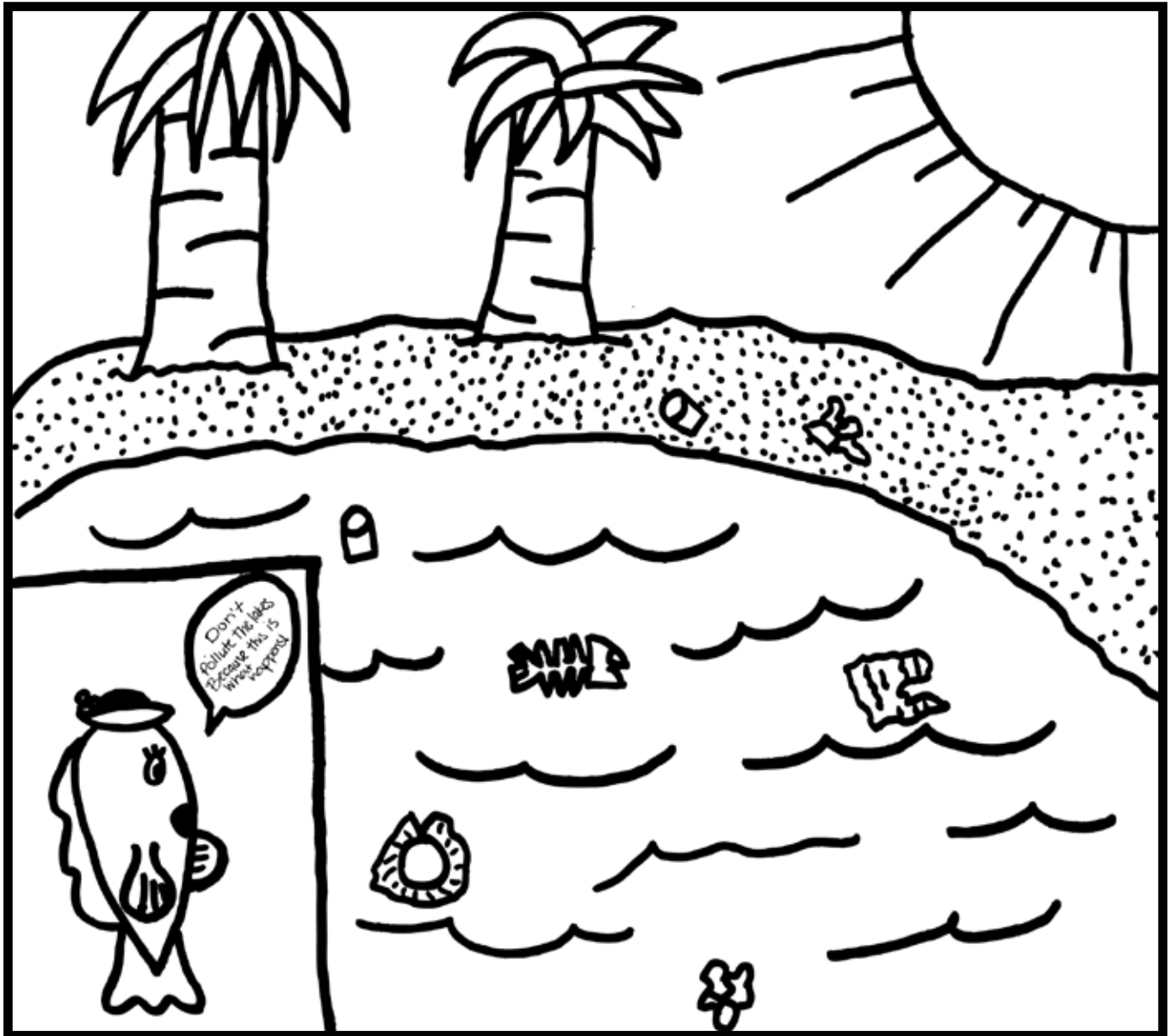
Keep your showers to five minutes or less to save water!

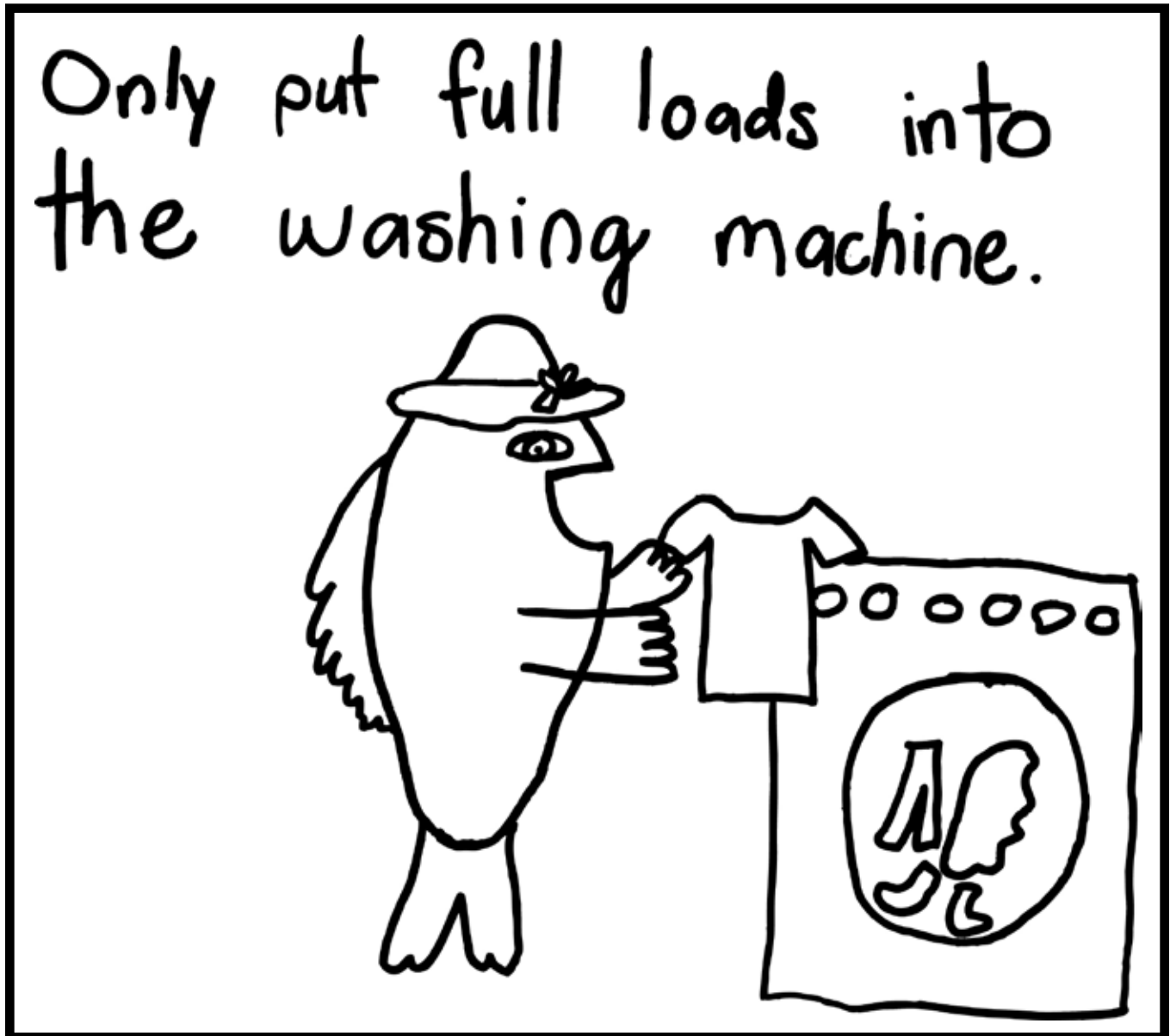

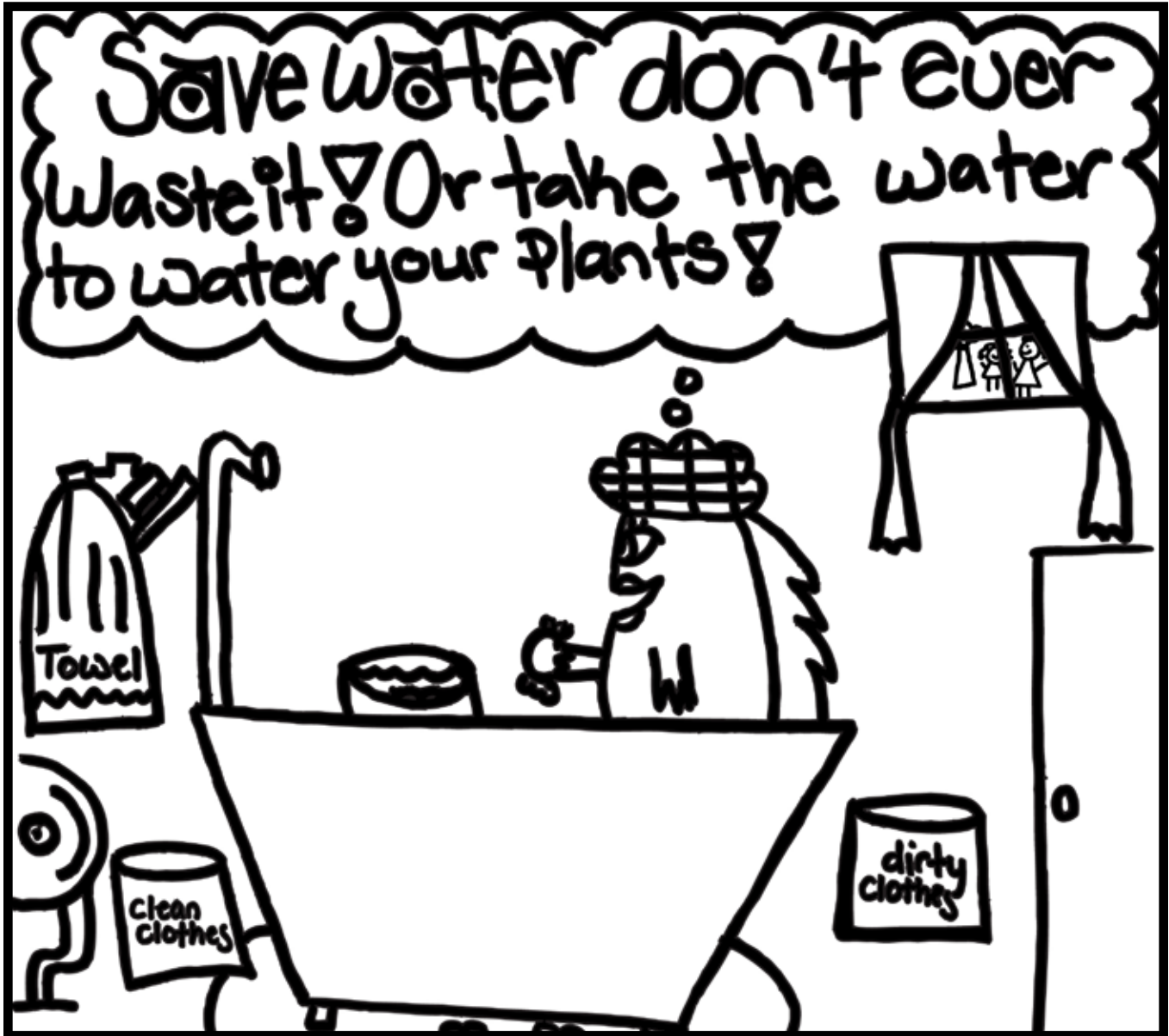

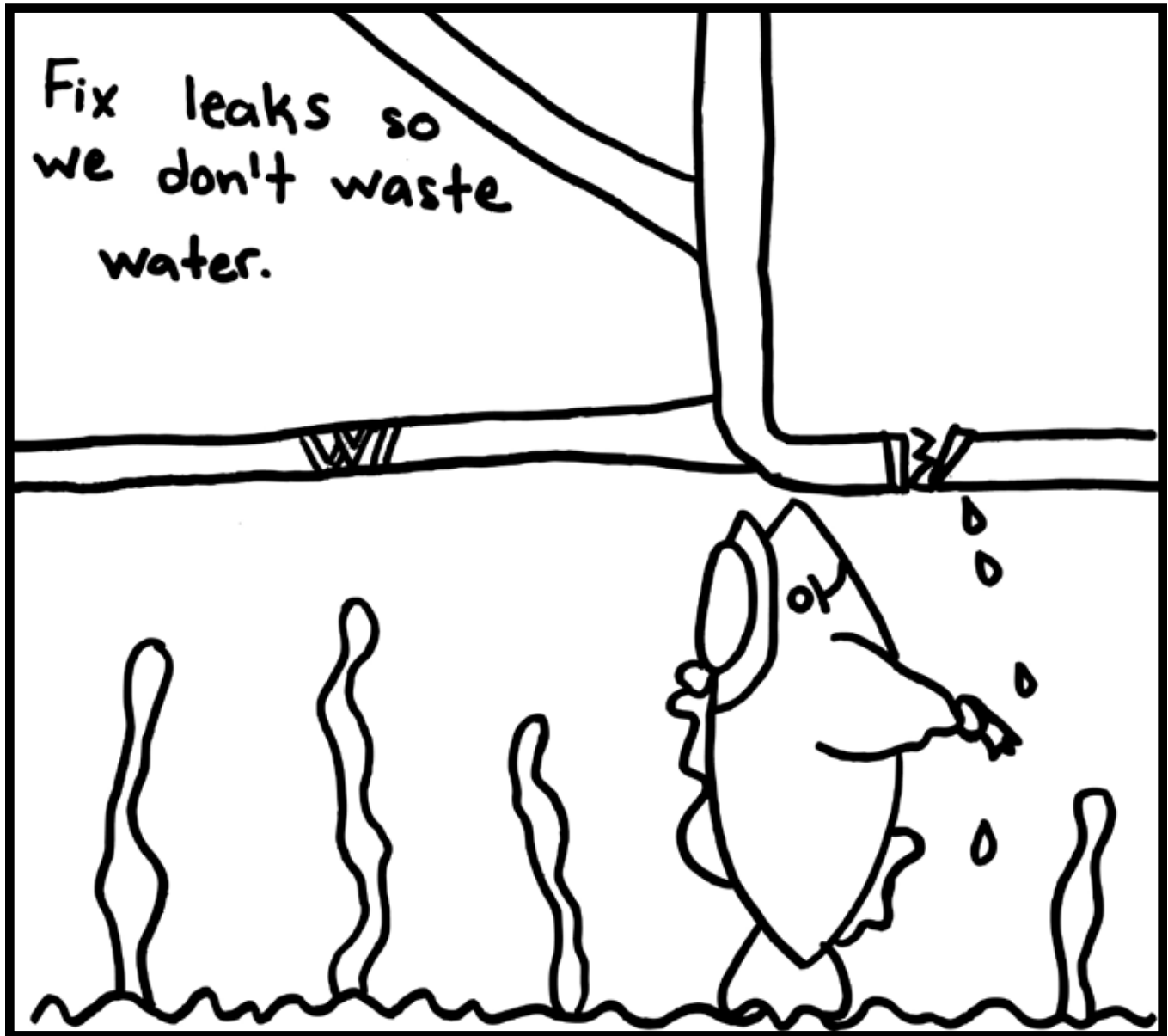
