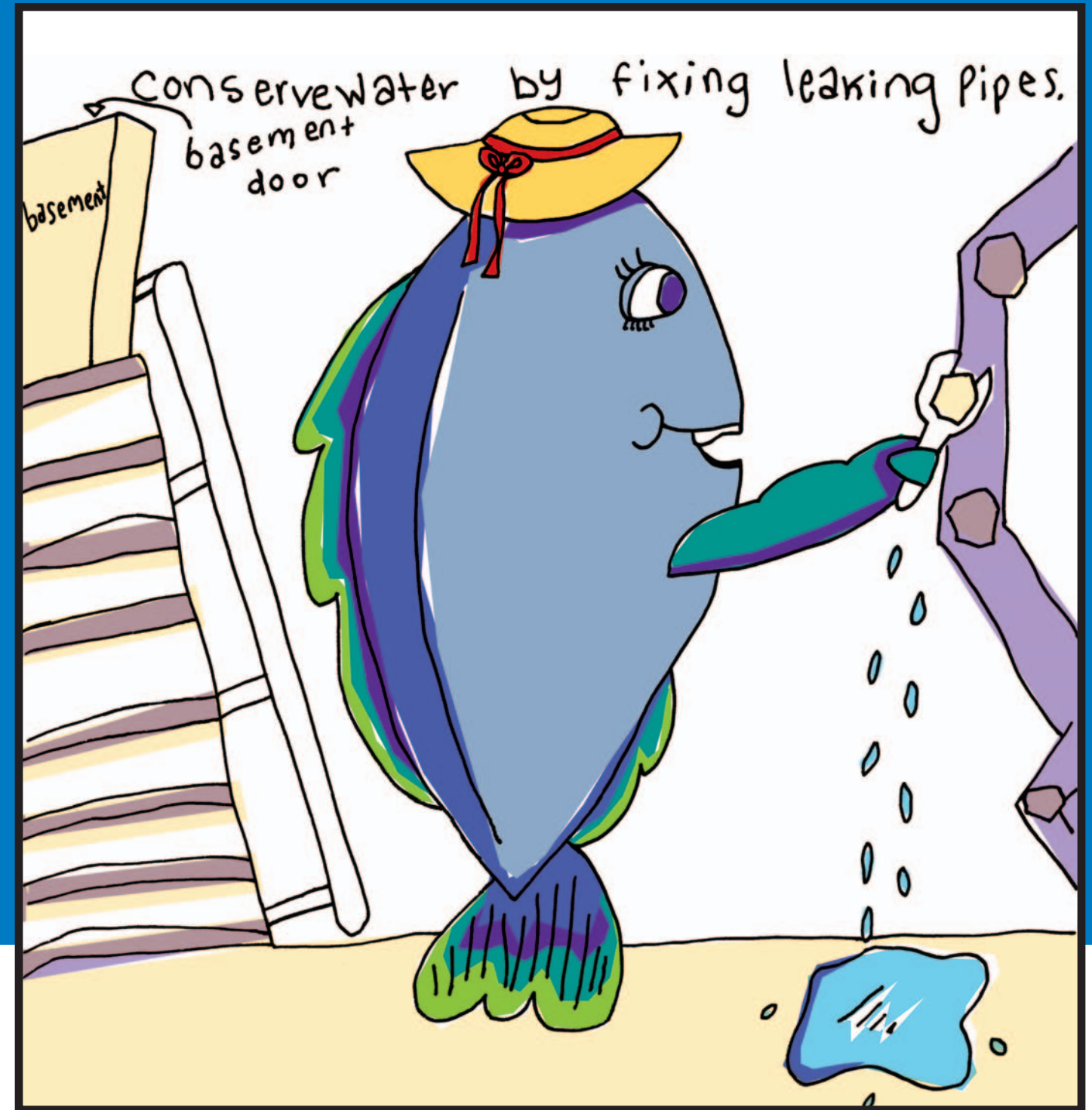

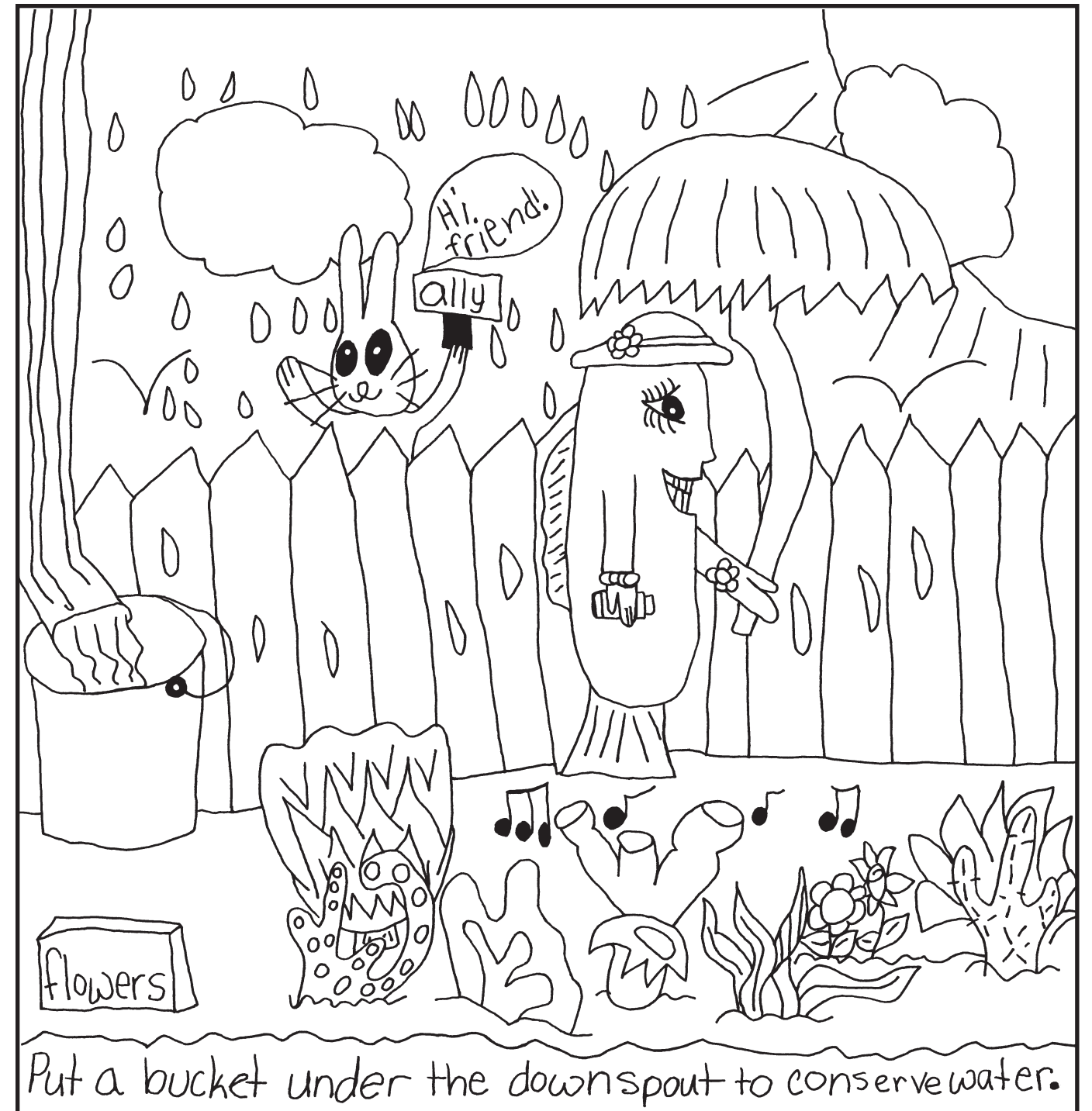


Ally Learns About Water Conservation

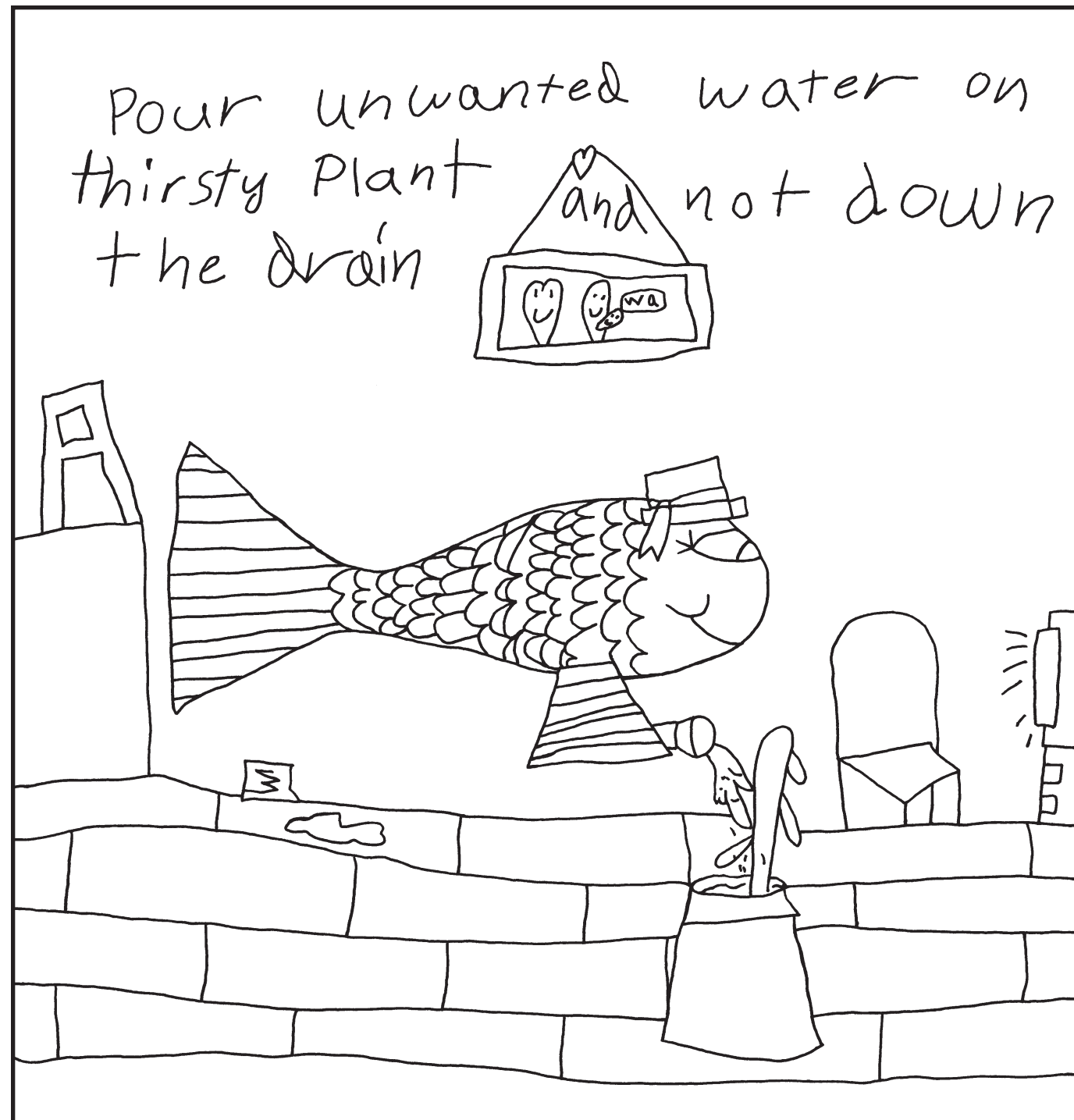

Put a bucket under the downspout to conserve water.

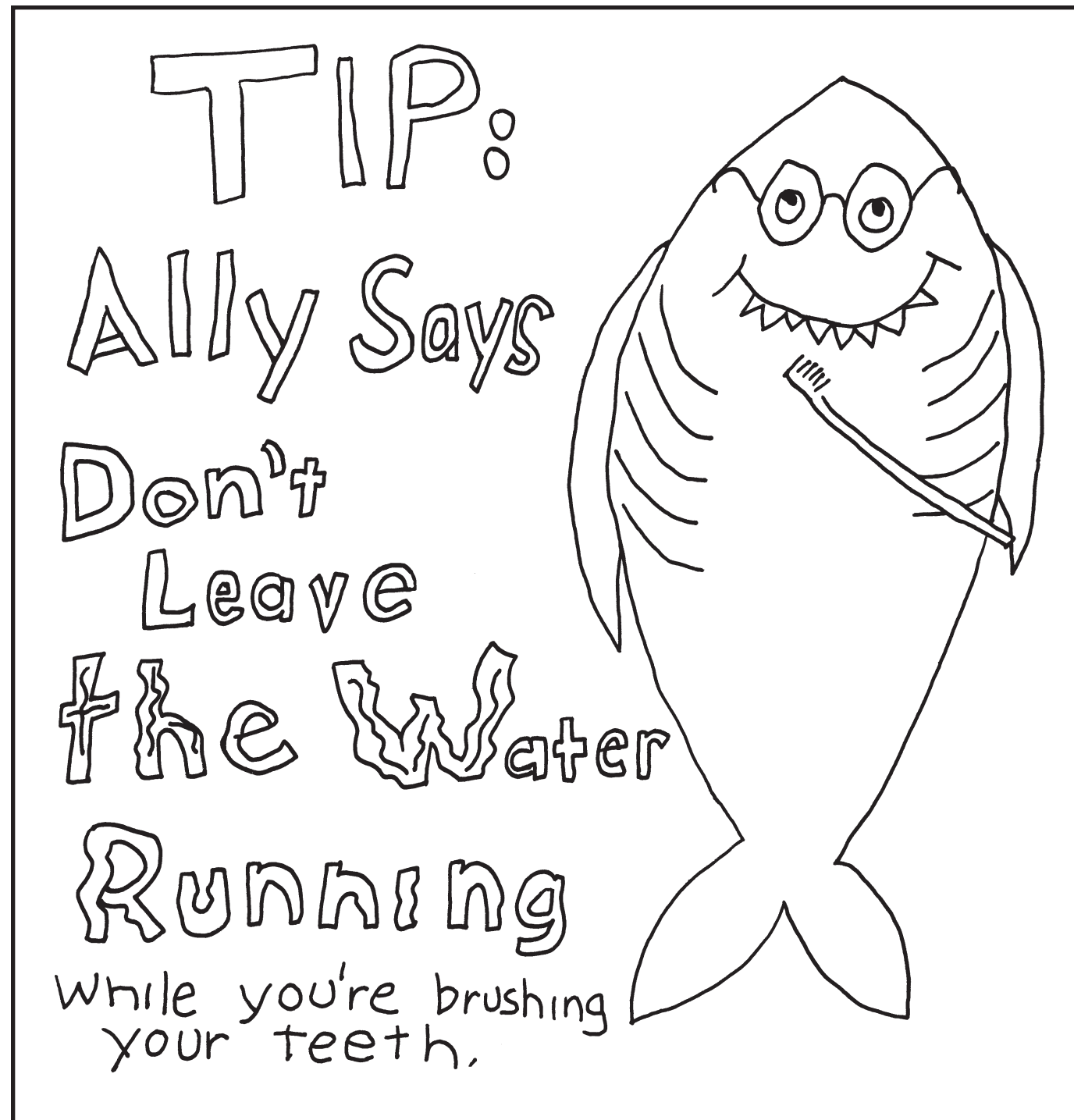
Put a rain barrel under the downspout to collect rain to water thirsty plants.



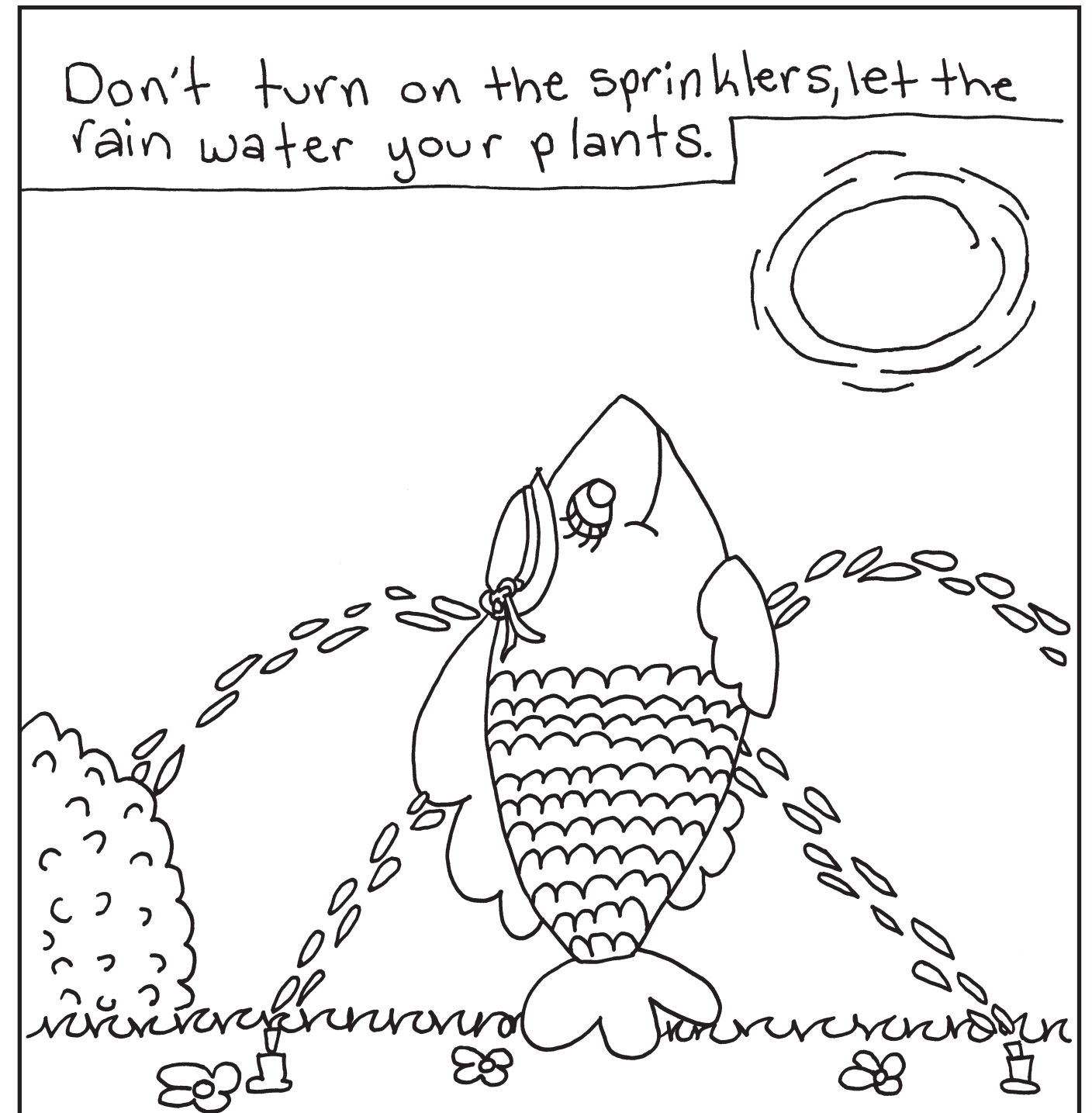
Pour unwanted water from your glass or bottle on a plant instead of down the drain.

Always turn off the faucet while you brush your teeth.



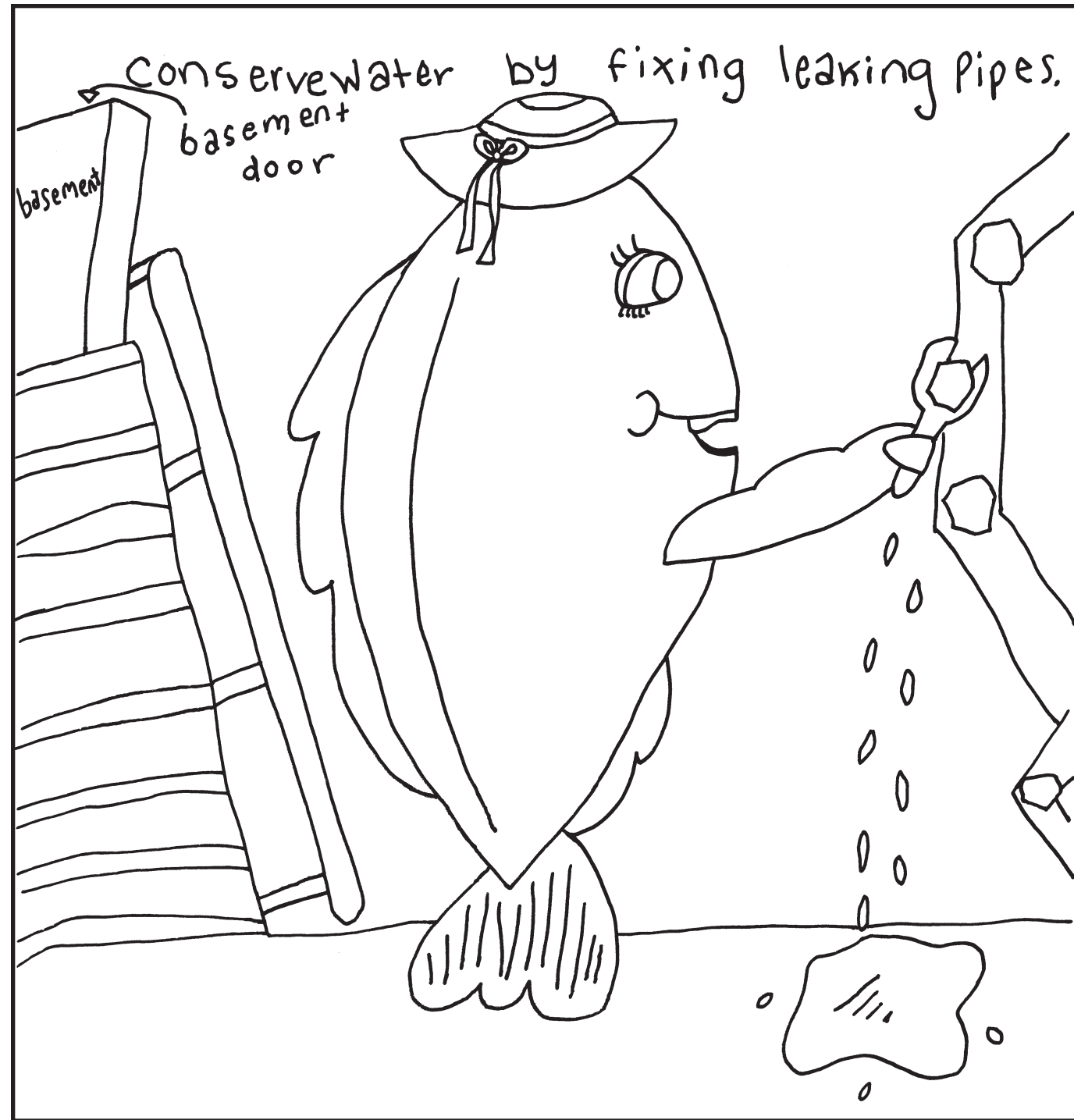
Let the rain water your plants instead of turning on sprinklers.



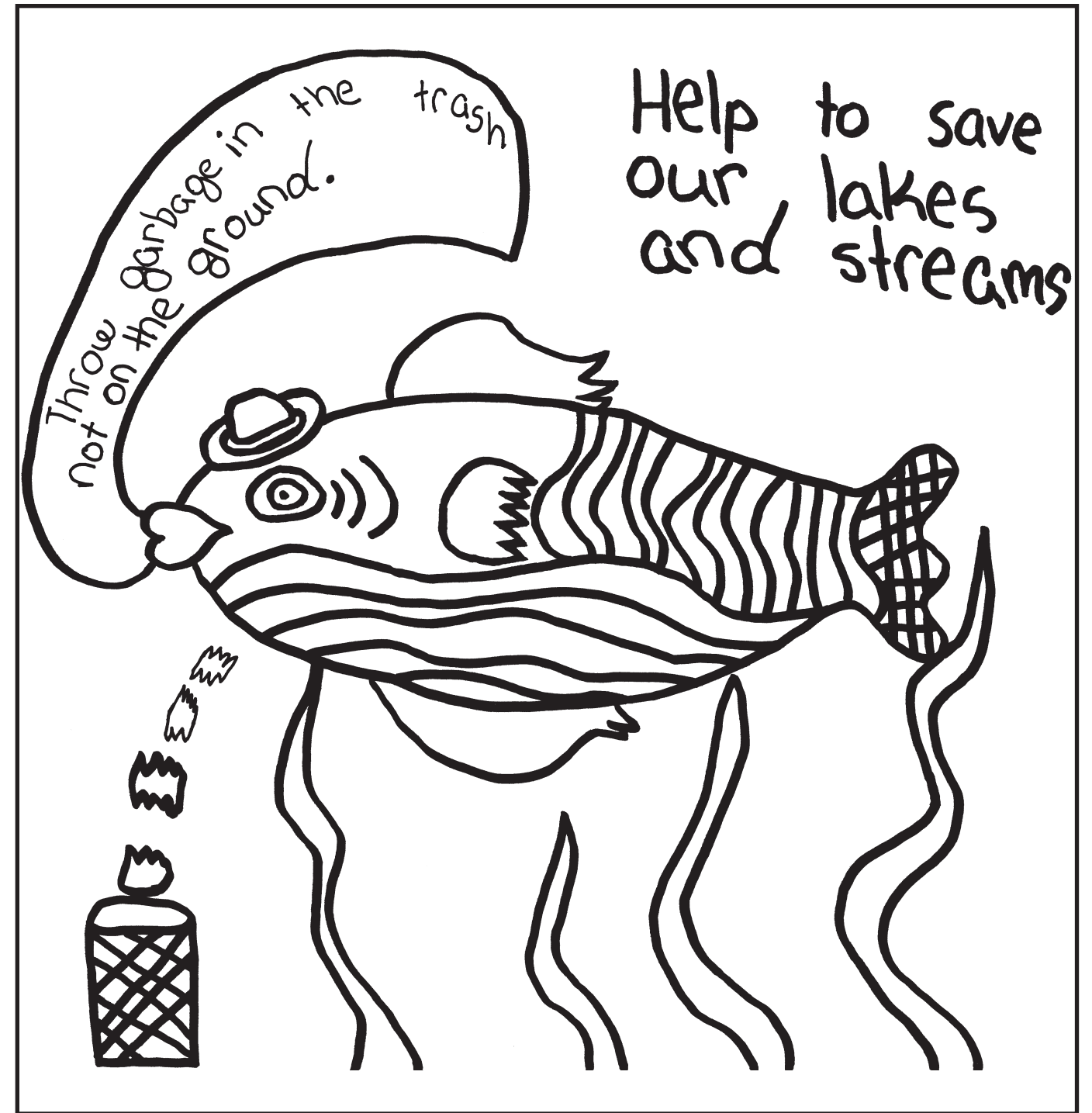
Turn off the shower while you lather up to help use less water.



Instead of washing your car, clean the inside to keep it feeling new without using water.



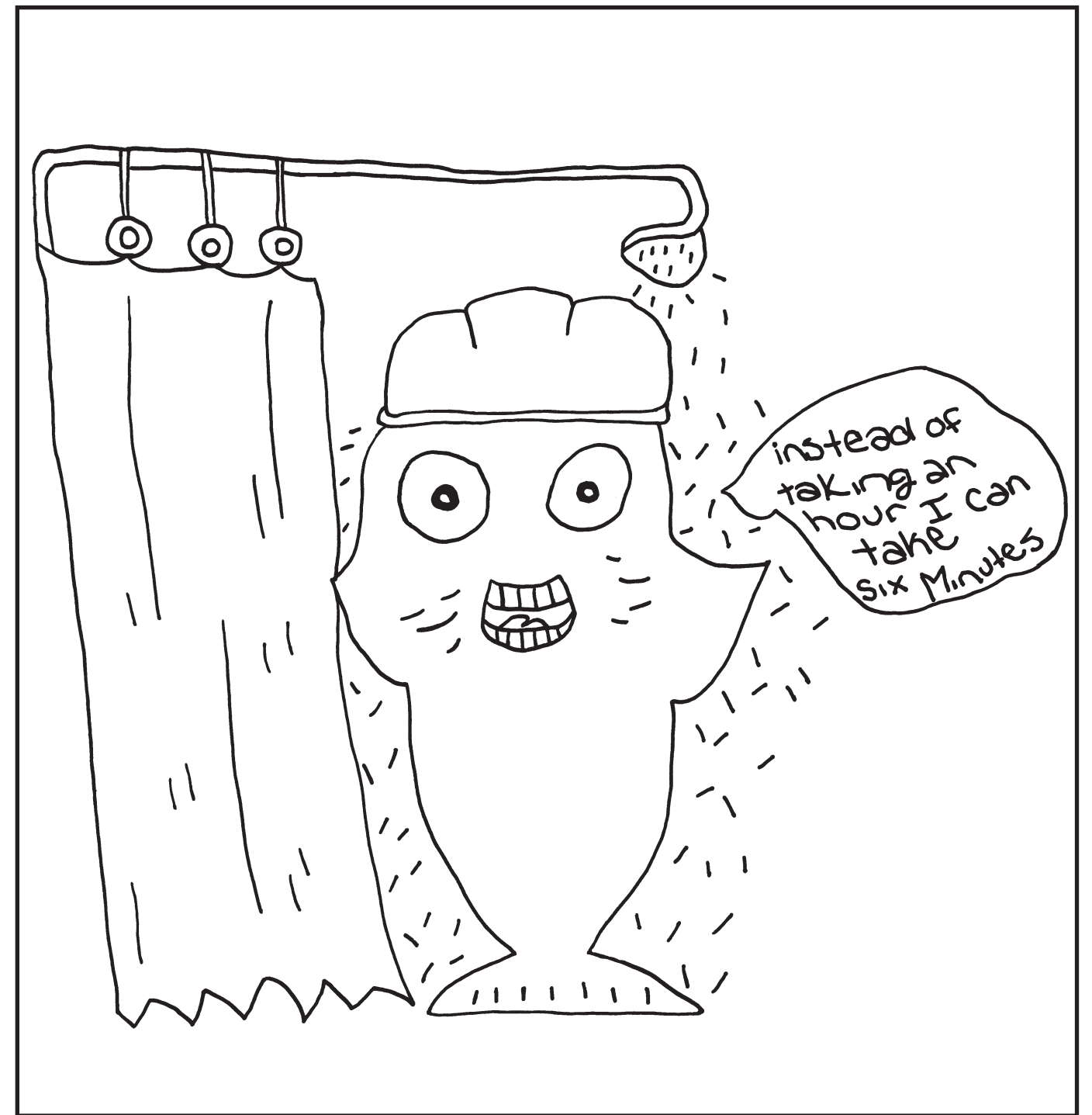
Conserve water by fixing leaky pipes.
